## CLERKS REPORT

- The Carnaby Windfarm Tree Planting Fund is now opened to applications from private and public landowners who wish to apply for funding for new tree, woodland and hedgerow planting. The Scheme is run by the Household Waste Recycling site. Details available via PC website. The PC is applying for a grant of £1,000 to purchase hedging plants. Three quotes have been received from Henleys, Thorpe Trees and Hedges Direct. Clerk will complete the application and submit form in due course. Parish Councillors have approved this application 16/20.
- Update from ERYC re public transport – changes to bus times and park and ride
- Update from Cllr Evison regarding manhole repair on Bridlington Bay Road – Yorkshire Water have now repaired this.
- Advanced Trees and Grounds have notified us of their services and are based in Filey and cover a wide range of arboriculture works.
- A bench has been purchased with remaining funds from the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Annual Grant and will be fixed in situ along Covert Lane.
- Mr Richard Stratford has offered to be the No Cold Calling representative for the Parish. Details passed onto ERYC.
- Power For People have sent an email regarding their campaign for a Local Electricity Bill and are asking Parish Councils to support them.
- ERYC are requesting volunteers to support a community response to assist those who are most vulnerable during the pandemic. If anyone is interested please contact [hive@heysmilefoundation.org](mailto:hive@heysmilefoundation.org)
- The PC has completed an application form for funding to build a small wall along Church Lane to prevent soil erosion and to maintain banking. Decisions will be made in the summer. ERYC Highways have stated that we need planning permission. Andrew Addison will confirm with Asset Team and get back to us regarding this. PC wish to inform ERYC about the overgrown trees around this area and for this to be looked at. Clerk to deal with this.
- Covid-19 Community Response Hub has been launched by ERYC and HEY Smile Foundation to provide additional support to help those most in need. More details can be found on the ERYC website.
- Quotes received for the building of the wall on Church Lane from Martin Adams and D B Lount and Son – these have been added to the application form
- Cllr Taylor raised a complaint on behalf of Mr Stabler regarding the burning and smoke coming from the wood opposite Manor Court and adjacent to Little Eden. Complaint made about commercial burning of building waste such as windows. Also a number of trees have been felled. PC have raised questions about whether appropriate licences have been obtained for disposing of commercial waste, tree felling/thinning and commercial use of green lane. Clerk will contact Ward Councillors/ERYC regarding investigation into this matter.
- There has been an increase in the number of people walking their dogs in Carnaby, with some owners not cleaning up after their dogs. Cllr Daniels will make signs and these will be distributed along the popular routes asking owners to clean up after their dog.
