**RESOLVED:** The PC strongly objects to this application as this a tourist development on a green field site. It borders a busy working farm which can operate from as early as 5.30am to midnight with heavy machinery in operation in the spring and summer months (May-Oct). It is feared that objections will arise from tourists about noise pollution if this application is granted. Also this site is adjacent to a Waste Transfer Site/Landfill site and is opposite a busy industrial estate. There is also no provision for sound deadening materials to be erected.

- Community Payback team email received – there are some transport difficulties at present but it is hoped that the team will be able to do some work in the Parish. Cllr Kitching and Cllr Burton met with Helen Gunn from ERYC. The CP team will need a regular day each week with toilet facilities and somewhere for them to eat their meal. It is hoped that something can be organised for next year.
- November crime mail was circulated – this will now cease due to lack of funding by Humberside Police
- Sticks Lane Speeding Decision email received – ERYC are unable to put in any measures as Sticks Lane has a good road safety record. ERYC consider this matter now closed.
- Chairman's Award 2016 are now open for nominations if anyone wishes to take part.
- Making Time For Winter leaflets were distributed at the meeting.
- Connect to Support email received from ERYC – there is a website now available to view for anyone needed support to live independently
- Coastal Opportunities Gateway letter from ERYC – update regarding coastal erosion and funding opportunities.
- Boat on roundabout – this has been taken by ERYC for renovation and will back on the roundabout in March 2016.
- Lissett Wind Farm funding still available for safeguarding vulnerable adults.
- Email from Cllr Evison – Sign has been requested for Waste Plant at Carnaby
- Festive Lighting permit received
- Complaint was received from member of the public about mud on road up Church Lane near the turning onto land owned by Mr Watts –Cllr Jackson will take this matter up with the owner.
- Cllr Daniels informed the PC that the company which is carrying out works for the new Wind Farm at Fraisthorpe have filled in a layby in 6" of soil and the layby is no longer there. He has contacted the company for this to be rectified.
