PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

Resident Adrian Clark (not present) has raised concerns over the state of Lowfield Lane. Cllr Lissetter will raise this issue with highways.

Street lamps on Main Street, Carnaby are hidden by overgrown hedges – ERYC to cut back hedging. Cllr Lissetter will raise issue with ERYC.

Road signs are needed for Haisthorpe – defibrillator has been installed on Woldgate Methodist Church but the lane has no name plate – Cllr Lissetter will ask ERYC to provide street signs.

Cllrs asked about ERYC's decision re AB Graphics planning as objections had been made about this application. Cllr Lissetter will look into this.

It was suggested that we get quotes to build a wall, and add lighting to light up walk way – perhaps with grant from Two Ridings/Fraisthorpe Wind Farm. Three quotes to be obtained. Cllr Burton will draw up plans.

2. Humber & Wolds Rural Action newsletter received – letter received about applying for membership – no interest in taking up this offer were made.
3. Letter from Barbara Holloway about adjusting the heating was received.
4. Rough sleeper survey received -no rough sleepers in Parish at present.
5. Received survey from ERYC about Independent Remuneration Panel regarding member's allowances.
6. Received and circulated information about new legislation on sewerage discharge from septic tanks.
7. Annual festive lighting forms to be completed- switch on for Christmas lights planned for 8th December to 5th January. GW to complete forms and send to ERYC.
8. Cllr Jackson proposed that we ask for a grant from the Wind Farm Fund to hire a beach hut for families to use. GW to enquire about costs and discuss further.
9. Cllrs Daniels proposed that we could ask for a grant from wind farm funds for heritage crafts such as blacksmithing events – costs approx. £150 per person per day. Cllr Daniels will obtain more details.
10. Defib training – newsletter to be circulated to Parish for more defib training – to be held in Haisthorpe – minimum of 10 confirmed places needed for training. Clerk to publish newsletter with details.
