PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

1. Discussed the complaint regarding Toft Lane wood – complaint has been passed to ERYC for investigation.
2. Discussed the NOD re Walter Wademan – once planning decision has been approved, Cllr Lissetter states that it cannot be appealed. Only if there has been an error in law can a judicial review be conducted. Cllr Lissetter will send Officers Report which gives details of the decision.

APPROVAL OF LAST MEETING'S MINUTES: minutes approved as a true record. 16 /20

MATTERS ARISING:

- CAM account – sent signed documentation to NATWEST regarding opening new bank account to receive funds from CAM once the charity has officially closed and handed the funds over the Parish Council for ongoing maintenance and costs of memorial. We have received further notification from them regarding Cllrs Daniels, Jackson and Kitching – signatories are displayed on account but are not linked to the account – further documentation to be completed in respect of this.
- Proposal for small wall along Church Lane – clerk has contacted ERYC and has been informed that we need planning permission. A site visit has been requested but no response has yet been received from Andrew Addison, Highways. Clerk tried to speak to Mr Addison today but was not available – waiting for return call.
- Brown Bin – Cllr Kitching would still like to meet with Wayne Bemrose to discuss position of a brown bin near the church.
- Traffic diversion via Carnaby – Cllr Jackson has asked if the road through Carnaby can be upgraded or made quieter if the diversion through the village is to remain. Cllr Lissetter will make enquiries.
- Bench – the owner of the land at Freshfields does not want the bench installed on their land, other sites have been looked at but deemed not suitable – suggested that the bench is now installed on the cliff top at Wilsthorpe, perhaps near the boat compound.
- Carnaby Tree Fund – clerk has sent an application in for this. ERYC are also running a similar funding - £5,000 per applicant can be applied for – it was agreed by all councillors present to apply for further funding for the Parish – anyone wishing to repair or make new hedges can ask the Parish Council for some hedging plants if application is approved 17/20
- Cllr Daniels reports that the sign on Sticks Lane has been taken. Clerk to ask ERYC for new signs, including those requested for HaisThorpe.
