1. Drains – Residents have still not been sent an apology from ERYC regarding the strongly worded letter that was sent to several residents down Moor Lane, Carnaby. Clerk will chase this up.
2. Eddie Stobbart trucks – no response was received from our email. A local resident has also complained to the company about the amount of trucks going down Moor Lane. This is not currently an issue due to road works in the village. This will be monitored to see if this recurs.
3. Boat – the boat has disappeared off the roundabout. We have not been notified of this so Clerk will make enquiries as to whether it is being repaired.

8: CLERK'S REPORT

- Festive lighting unmetered supplies – we have received the annual forms to complete about the Festive Lights electrical supply. The Christmas lights will be switched on shortly – Sunday 5th December at at 6pm and remain on until 5th January 2015.
- Christmas - Santa is booked again for this year. It is proposed that we will use the planted Christmas tree this year as it is now a good size. More lights will be purchased to decorate. It was suggested that a reindeer and sleigh decoration would be purchased. Cllr Kitching will look into this.
- Clerk will organise mince pies (2 dozen) and sausage rolls (3 dozen) from Milners. Mulled wine will be supplied by Manor Court Hotel. Ferns Farm will be asked if they wish to supply any food. Cllr Daniels will buy sweets for the children. Cllr

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Kitching will ask Mr and Mrs Robinson about displaying a tree in their garden and using their electricity supply for the lights. Cllr Jackson will purchase a tree for Haisthorpe.

- Newsletter – Cllr Daniels will put together a newsletter informing people of the Christmas festivities etc.
- Cllr Kitching will meet Helen Gunn from ERYC regarding the Community Pay Back team to see if they can be of assistance in the village. The meeting is due on the 10th November at 12.30.
- Helen Reynolds form Parish Transport team will be attending next month's meeting to inform us about local transport which is available for residents.
- Anti-social behaviour team has forwarded an update about anti-social behaviour in the local area.
- British Red Cross have sent an appeal for a donation towards an ambulance. No donation given as this is not a service that has been seen in the area.
- Humberside Police have issued their crime report for October 2015 – this was circulated at the meeting.
- Road closures – there are two proposed closures in the village, the first one will be on the evening of the 21st November on Bridlington Bay Road Level Crossing, the second is on 9th February, again on Bridlington Bay Road Level Crossing.
- Lawn Mower – Cllr Kitching is looking into purchasing a new mower at a cost of £983.00 from Cherrys. This is at a greatly reduced cost due to discounts. All were in agreement at this purchase.
