Rachel requested £500 from the annual wind farm fund which the PC granted in full.

Defibrillator for Haisthorpe has now arrived and will be installed shortly. Clerk to contact Barbara Holloway prior to installation. Cllr Kitching to contact the electrician for a quote for wiring it in. A letter will be sent to Parishioners in Haisthorpe asking if they would like training on the defib. A minimum number of participants will be required to attend due to costs. Confirmation of attendees is required. Clerk to organise this.
