Wind Farm Funding



We are pleased to announce that we have been granted funding of £1,356.00 from the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Fund for more litter bins and litter picking equipment. The litter bins have now been installed around the Parish and we have received the litter picking equipment.

We have also received a grant for a defibrillator from the Lissett Wind Farm Fund, which we have now purchased. This will be installed in the telephone kiosk in Carnaby in due course. We will be formally adopting the kiosk, once this has been finalised we will then install the defibrillator into the kiosk. As a temporary measure the defibrillator will be fixed to the wall near the kiosk.

The Parish Council will also receive an annual sum of £1,500 from the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm. This fund is open to spend on small projects within the Parish. Parishioners are asked to contact us for details of how to apply.
