
CHRISTMAS LIGHTS SWITCH ON.

Wind Farm Funding



We are pleased to announce that we have been granted funding of £2,010 from the Lissett Wind Farm Fund. We will be purchasing more defibrillators for the Parish. We will install one at Haisthorpe on the Woldgate Methodist Church and Community Centre, one on the industrial estate on the building belonging to Carnaby Caravans and a third one will be installed near the boat compound at Wilsthorpe.

The Parish Council will receive an annual sum of £1,500 from the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm in April next year. This fund is open to spend on small projects within the Parish. If any Parish group or organisation wishes to apply for a small grant of up to £500 please contact us either by email:
