Fraisthorpe wind farm fund update

The Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund has granted £1,500 to the Parish once again. Small grants of up to £500 are available to help clubs, groups or projects that benefit the residents of Carnaby Parish.

Grants recently awarded were allocated to a group of residents in Wilsthorpe to make small repairs to their community which were not covered under statutory requirements by ERYC, local members of the Bridlington Young Farmers were awarded a grant to purchase white coats for stock judging competitions, grass cutting in Carnaby church and funding towards defibrillators.

Anyone wishing to apply for a small grant should contact the Parish Council or their local Parish Councillor, with details of their organisation or group, what they wish to spend the grant on and the amount requested. Funds will be allocated at the discretion of the Parish Council. Funds cannot be allocated to private businesses, national organisations, for the advancement of religion, for overseas holidays, work which does not directly benefit people living in the area of the benefit or work that is undertaken by or on behalf of statutory bodies, work undertaken by or on behalf of schools, colleges or universities as part of their statutory curricular activities, or work where the main beneficiaries are animals. This criteria is set by Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Fund and not by the Parish Council.

Lissett Wind Farm Fund

Funding has once again been secured from the Lissett Wind Farm Fund to purchase another defibrillator. This will be installed in Haisthorpe at the Woldgate Methodist Church and Community Centre. Our Parish will then be fully covered with four defibrillators:

- 1. Church Lane, Carnaby (next to the new memorial)
- 2. Lancaster Road, Carnaby Industrial Estate (Carnaby Caravans building)
- 3. Wilsthorpe (near the boat compound)



Defibrillator Training

Once the defibrillator is installed in Haisthorpe, we will organise another training session to be held at Woldgate Methodist Church and Community Centre. The training will be free of charge to attendees. All parishioners welcome to attend.

To open in an emergency

- 1. Call 999
- 2. Keep calm and follow instructions
- 3. Inform the call operator of your location
- 4. You will be given an unlock code
- 5. Stay on the line for further guidance
