PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

Cllr Evison was informed of the fly tipping incident that occurred recently involving a parishioner. The clerk has drafted a copy of a letter to be sent to the parishioner in question. This letter was circulated prior to the meeting and will be now be sent to the parishioner.

Cllr Evison will chase up the discrepancy regarding the parish council tax as we have not received a reply as to why the precept has risen, given that the number of chalets that was previously stated as being removed was inaccurate. Cllr Burton performed a physical check and found that only 1 x chalet had been demolished and 5 x new chalets had been built.

Power station at Wilsthorpe- a layby is now being made near the site.

Temple Lane – vegetation overgrown road – Village task force have completed their inspection and householders will be asked to trim their hedges.

Main Street – there is a query as to whether a vehicle has been abandoned (opposite Ferns Farm Hotel). Enquiries will be made (Cllr Jackson).

Cllr Jackson raised issues about blocked drains on the A614 Carnaby to Brid road and uneven road down Sands Wood (leading to Boynton). Cllr Evison will raise both issues with ERYC.

Cllr Langham queried how often wheelie bins are replaced as some are damaged down Moor Lane. Cllr Evison will make enquiries

Annual insurance has been paid.

Lighting issues around church – funding has been refused, ERYC have informed PC that there is no statutory obligation or funding to put in further street lighting. Clerk will enquire as to what other options are available (eg PC to purchase low level lighting).

We have received 2 invites, one from ERYC about a wildlife photography exhibition at Beverley, the other a talk about Yorkshire Farming and Wildlife given by Chris Thomson RSPB. Cllr Daniels may attend the exhibition, the talk information will be attached to notice boards.

Cllr Daniels will tidy up the area behind the Pound.

Grass cutting was discussed -churchyard to be cut again during the summer months, Mr Artley will be asked to keep the Pound area tidy as well.
