9: CLERKS REPORT:

1. Email sent to Dave England 12.03.13 – Highways re drains flooding – no response as yet
2. Fuel poverty – vulnerable residents (over 70 and in receipt of means tested benefit and have a long term health condition) are eligible for insulation/heating support – contact Peter Hirschfeld at Humber and Wolds Rural Community Council on 01430 43047 peter.hirschfeld@hwrec.org.uk or Jane Mears at ERYC 01482 434047 jane.mears@eastriding.gov.uk if criteria is met
3. Collective Switching scheme “YORSwitch” - ERYC has obtained a grant from the Dept of Energy and Climate Change to support this scheme (cheaper energy). Household in ER can register now to take part . Campaign to start soon.
4. Coastal Change Drop in Sessions were held in February – regarding coastal erosion – nothing to report

5. Web site – domain name www.carnabyparishcouncil.co.uk – web site under development. Councillors to view website and advise clerk of any changes they wish to make or add.
6. Spring and Summer halfterm activities – details to go on website.
7. Thank you letter received from Carnaby Church and receipt for donation
8. Gypsy site – Biffa sent further objection via ERYC site, Duraco and local resident letter and letter from St Quintin’s creamery received. Heritage lottery sharing programme – can apply for grants £3,00-£10,000
9. Letter from St Quintins creamery re gypsy site plan
10. Burton Agnes Parish Council and Lissett and Ulrome are forming a joined Parish Council Network – Carnaby Parish Council has expressed an interest in this scheme. Further details to follow
11. Lissett Windfarm fund – application workshops available to attend to help individuals complete applications.
12. Gypsy site response letter from ERYC – this letter did not answer the bullet points raised. Parish Council to write again to ask for clarification about selection criteria.
13. Register of Pecuniary Interests – Parish Councillors have submitted these in the past – clerk to correspond to Mathew Buckley Monitoring Officer querying this
14. Heritage Lottery Sharing Programme Scheme – Parish Council to apply for funding re Carnaby Aerodrome to erect a Memorial re Lancaster Bomber pilots and airmen who lost their lives during WW2
15. Mobile library times – no change to services. Information will be put on website
16. Footpaths in Carnaby, Church Lane, Moor Lane and Main Road – footpaths are in disrepair or need cleaning – clerk to contact ERYC re maintenance of paths. Clerk to contact Max Robinson re to enquire about any difficulties in access to church. Pothole down Lowfield Lane, Haisthorpe – clerk to advise Dave England, Highways.
17. Waste disposal – opening times have altered and the site will now close at 5pm. There is concern that this will encourage fly tipping. Clerk to correspond with ERYC re altering of opening times to 6pm instead of 5pm.
18. Speed limit – Haisthorpe – concern was raised about traffic speeding through Haisthorpe village. Recent accident in village caused by vehicles travelling too quickly and not allowing for traffic turning onto main road from side street. Clerk to enquire about a reduction in speed limit through village.
