

# CARNABY PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES

## **PUBLIC QUESTION TIME**

1. Manhole covers on Moor Lane – cones have been in place for several weeks – no sign of any repairs – Cllr Evison to look into this
2. Cllr Jackson made enquires about ash trees on council property and how often are they inspected. Cllr Evison advised that they are regularly inspected.
3. Cllr Evison informed the PC that ERYC have trees to give away – recent announcement following ERYC budget for the next year, funding will also be made available for flood areas.
4. No plans as yet for ERYC to increase the number of electrical charging points for electric cars as yet
5. Kingsgate road surfacing – once all roadworks have been completed, Cllr Jackson has requested that the council re-direct traffic via the low road instead of through the village as traffic has increased considerably and it is difficult to cross the road
6. Road signs needed for Haisthorpe and Sticks Lane in Carnaby – Cllr Evison to chase up.

### **CLERKS REPORT**

1. Cllr Taylor discussed handing over funding from CAM – PC will need to arrange another bank account for CAM funding. It was agreed that a new account would be opened for the funding to be transferred into. Direct debit will also be transferred to pay for insurance
2. Two Ridings Wind Farm application for funding for wall on Church Lane has now commenced. It was suggested that undertaker Max from Brighams Undertakers will be asked to act as a referee. Clerk will make enquiries
3. Residents on Moor Lane have received a letter from the RSPCA explaining that the purchase of Cloverdale is for use as a wildlife and conservation area and will not be used for kennelling of dogs or domestic cats.
4. Future funding from the annual wind farm fund could go towards repairing the private road at Wilsthorpe near the flats as the road is in poor repair again.
5. Other grants available via ERYC are "Safe and Sound" grant, VE Day Grant and Tour De Yorkshire grant for residents to apply for.
