FRAISTHORPE WIND FARM FUND UPDATE

The Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund has granted £1,500 to the Parish once again. Small grants of up to £500 are available to voluntary organisations, community groups and small charities or projects that support charitable, educational, community, environmental or general amenity projects within the Parish Council area of Carnaby.

Anyone wishing to apply for a small grant should contact the Parish Council or their local Parish Councillor, with details of their organisation or group, what they wish to spend the grant on and the amount requested. Funds will be allocated at the discretion of the Parish Council.

Funds cannot be allocated to private businesses, national organisations, for the advancement of religion, for overseas holidays, work which does not directly benefit people living in the area of the benefit or work that is undertaken by or on behalf of statutory bodies, work undertaken by or on behalf of schools, colleges or universities as part of their statutory curricular activities, or work where the main beneficiaries are animals. This criteria is set by Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Fund and not by the Parish Council.

Defibrillator installed at Carnaby

Funding has been secured from the Lissett Wind Farm Fund. A defibrillator has now been purchased and installed on the Pound, Church Lane, Carnaby. The defibrillator is housed in a locked cabinet for security. Should an emergency arise and the defibrillator is needed, please dial 999. The Ambulance Service will give out the code so that the cabinet can be unlocked and the defibrillator removed for use.

The Parish Council has applied for further funding for two more defibrillators. These will be installed in the villages of Haisthorpe and Wilsthorpe.



DEFIBRILLATOR TRAINING

The Parish Council has organised a training session in how to use defibrillators with funding from the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm. The Yorkshire Ambulance Service will conduct the training. The session will be held on: **Monday, 21st May 2018 at 7pm, at Ferns Farm Hotel.** Everyone welcome to attend.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF DEFIBRILLATOR

To open in an emergency

1. Call 999
2. Keep calm and follow instructions
3. Tell the call operator you are at location AAQ82
4. You will be given an unlock code
5. Stay on the line for further guidance
