5. MATTERS ARISING:

- 1.The Bench has now been installed on Moor Lane near John Bull Rock.
- 2.Quotes - East Riding College have not submitted any quotes for the noticeboard.
- 3.Noticeboards – it was agreed that Albert Thundercliffe will be asked to make the noticeboard. It is planned to be installed by the 1st October.
4. Email response from Cllr Lissetter – ERYC will assess the road markings in Carnaby and arrangements to have them refreshed will be undertaken as required; cycle lane down Moor Lane, it was noted that it was possible to join the carriageway at John Bull Rock. The Transport Strategy dept will be able to advise further regards plans to improve the cycle path; ERYC will not install bollards to protect land only to protect pedestrians or avoid collision with a structure; it is hoped that ERYC will inspect white lines and manhole covers in the near future. Cllr Lissetter will ask if a lower cost alternative would be supported with funding from the Parish. Clerk will ask ERYC/Cllr Lissetter; verge cutting has been reduced in the county due to budget restraints.
