- Cllr Daniels has been in contact with Neil Archbutt re RAF building down Sticks Lane, who will provide an update in the next 2-3 weeks.
- Tree in Churchyard has been damaged by winds – Rev Trousdale has been in touch with a tree surgeon to inspect the damage and possible removal of tree
- Two trees at Bessingby on verge are potentially dangerous, posing a risk to motorists – ERYC will inspect trees
- Cycle path at South Shore – there is the potential that funding for a coastal path could be found. Cllr Evison will make enquires. Cllr Lissetter has reported that ERYC will not help fund or maintain such a path.
- No update as yet re Wilsthorpe Campsite
- Cllr Evison will look into crime funding for surveillance cameras for the Parish
