PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

The issue of speeding through Haisthorpe was raised at the meeting. An accident at Moor Farm occurred recently and local resident Adrian Clark has asked if anything can be done to calm traffic down. Cllr Evison has suggested that we contact Highways. Clerk to contact ERYC.

4. MATTERS ARISING:

1. Potholes – Rob Brown from ERYC will ask an officer to inspect the potholes in the Parish. They will also send Yorkshire Water a defect notice as the manholes belong to them.
2. Cycle path – Wilsthorpe-to Brid coast path. Cllr Jackson raised the issue of whether a cycle path can be created along the coast as the path does not continue along into Bridlington. Cllr Evison will look into this.
3. Newsletter- a newsletter will be distributed around the village to encourage applications for the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm.
4. Little Eden – Little Eden have been clearing woodland and land adjacent to Brid Bay Road. Tress have been cut. It is unclear why they are clearing this area. Concerns were raised about this. Cllr Evison to raise this issue with ERYC.

5. Wind Farm Fund

Applications are now open for the Fraisthorpe Wind Farm. GW has sent in an application for more litter bins and litter picking equipment. GW has also applied to Lissett Wind Farm for a defibrillator for the Parish.

We have received a form from Two Ridings Foundation Committee to complete to receive £1,500 grant money which the Parish can allocate to groups who ask for small donations (less than £500).

GW asked the committee if there is anything the Parish Council would like to apply for. GW suggested looking at encouraging health and fitness in the community such as a reduced membership for the Palms for pensioners and children. Cllr Daniels has looked at prices. This was discussed. More details of how this would work are needed.

Other suggestions were funding for Burton Agnes school (eg sports equipment/activities), a new ride on lawn mower, and wildlife camera. Cllr Kitching will look into prices for a new mower, GW will look into prices for wildlife cameras.
