PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

- 1.Potholes on Lowfield Lane, Haisthorpe – 20 potholes will be shortly be repaired by ERYC.
2. Building on Sticks Lane, Carnaby – Cllr Daniels reported that more fly tipping had occurred at this site – including syringes and prescription drugs. Has been reported to ERYC about fly tipping but no action has been taken to prevent this. Building needs to be demolished or a door to be put on.
- 3.Road sweeper will shortly be visiting the Parish to clean the roads.
4. Gullies need to be cleaned following the repair of the roads with chippings.
- 5.Cllr Jackson asked for a traffic survey to count the number of cars coming through the village as this has increased recently due to building and road works in Bridlington – traffic is being diverted via Carnaby. It is now difficult for traffic to cross over lanes and for pedestrians to cross the road. Cllr Evison to enquire.
- 6.Trees at Bessingby are still a potential threat to motorist – Cllr Jackson raised this issue again.

3. Gardener at Sticks Lane has been approached for a quote for grass cutting – Cherry's have a bushcutter to hire for £50 per day. Mr Hartley has been approached for cutting the church grass but no response as yet. Grass cutting has been arranged for Friday for volunteers.
4. Church rail has broken – GW has spoken to Rev G Owen who will look into this matter.
5. Northern Powergrid – they have been informed about the defib in situ – no response. Contract has not yet been signed – no further communications received.
6. BT payphone – we have paid £1.00 for the adoption of kiosk but as we no longer want it clerk to contact BT for refund.
