Over hanging trees down Church Lane – ERYC have responded stating that this tree is not on ERYC property. They have suggested that we contact the adjoining householder. Clerk will chase this up.

ERYC have sent a letter informing us of modifications to the local plan – this can be viewed on line via ERYC website.

Dogs on leads – notices will be issued by ERYC informing residents that anyone taking their dog through the churchyard should have their dog on a lead. This is a ruling from ERYC and not Rev Owen.

Temporary road closures – A165 layby off Bridlington Road and part of Church Road Fraisthorpe commencing 6th October and Hunger Hills Balk, Carnaby commencing on 2nd March 2015.

Free Trees –Councillor Evison forwarded a notice regarding free trees. There was no interest from PC at the meeting.

Railway crossing – a resident in Wilsthorpe has complained about the level crossing lights at Carnaby – they do not give sufficient warning for slow moving traffic to pass safely across. It was also noticed by Parish Councillors that the lights flash red again once the barriers have been raised. Network Rail will be contacted to check this out.
