7: CLERKS REPORT

- Cllr Jackson has asked if we can obtain a grant to put a cycle path in between Wilsthorpe and Bridlington- this will complete the cycle path that is currently in situ. Clerk will ask Cllr Lissetter to look at the possibility of gaining permission for this over ERYC land.
- ERYC Rob Brown has replied about the potholes in Haisthorpe (Lowfield Lane). The lane was inspected in July and works to repair actionable pothole defects were ordered and completed on 26th July. Rob Brown states in his email dated 15.08.17 that the lane does not pose an immediate risk to either cyclists or motorcyclists.
- Litter picking kits from Helping Hand are £32.00 per kit – Clerk to order 10 kits.
- Christmas lighting – Cllr Jackson asked if new lighting can be funded by the Windfarm fund. Cllr Kitching has a lumalite catalogue and will check out prices.
- ERYC have sent information about Speed Indicator Detectors (SIDS) to hire, 1 x £450 for 4 weeks (2 = £500 per 4 weeks hire). Deemed to be too expensive. It was suggested that we have a traffic survey next July/Aug in Carnaby. Traffic has increased significantly since renovation works were carried out in Bridlington. Traffic has been redirected via Carnaby.
- CAM update – CAM have withdrawn from the proposed site of the memorial at Manor Court and are looking for other viable alternatives. They are now looking at a much smaller memorial on land in the village.
