**PUBLIC QUESTION TIME**

**1. APOLOGIES:** Cllr Evison, Cllr Owen

1. Pot holes in Haisthorpe – the roads are now in very poor repair. ERYC informed the PC a year ago that they would be mended but this has not yet happened. Cllr Lissetter will chase this up.

2. Haisthorpe – speeding. Paul Copeland from ERYC has contacted us to inform us that the cost of flashing sign is approx. £4-5000 to install and will cost about 10% of the installation cost year to maintain and run. Over a 10 year period this would add up to £9-10,000 and would need to be funded in advance.

3. Fibre optic broadband. Cllr Langham has asked when this will be working. Apparently, residents have to contact their broadband provider to be connected to it. There is a financial cost to this by some providers.

4. Car parking fees. Cllr Burton raised the issue of why the Leisure World car park has a different system to other car parking in East Yorkshire. Blue Badge holders can park for free in other car parks but not in Leisure World. Fines are issued to those who do not pay to park. Cllr Lissetter to make enquiries.

**7: CLERKS**

- Healthwatch have contacted us to say they would like to attend coffee mornings to spread the word about their service. Clerk to pass information to Rev Trowsdale.
- Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Fund – we have had several requests from the community with ideas of how to spend the funding. Sylvia Grundy has requested that more litter bins are provided in the village, especially down Lowfield Lane opposite Manor Farm entrance and near the Chapel as these areas are the worst for dog fouling. Mrs Goldthorpe has requested that trees are planted to screen the industrial estate. A resident from Wilsthorpe has asked that a litter bin be provided on the cliff top as there are problems with dog fouling and plastic bags with dog litter in them are being discarded. Clerk to contact ERYC about bins and installation/collection. Cllr Burton/Cllr Taylor have got 2 quotes for ride on mowers – Wilfred Scruton Iseki SXG216 is £6,210 + VAT, Cherry's RRP £5,257 + VAT
- ERYC have sent an email regarding draft documentation for the Lower Derwent Valley for public consultation –this can be viewed on ERYC website.
- Coastal Path – Wilsthorpe – Cllr Evison has forwarded an email to say that the England Coast Path will link Wilsthorpe and the Park and Ride and then onto Bridlington in due course.
- Humberside Police have forwarded on the Crime Report. . There were two crimes committed on the Industrial Estate.
- Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund – we have been awarded £1,356 from our recent application for litter picking equipment and litter bins. There is a grant acceptance form to be completed and forwarded to Two Ridings.
- Seafarers UK have contacted us by letter to ask if we will fly the Red Ensign for Merchant Navy Day – as we do not have a flag pole we are unable to accommodate their request.
- Cllr Taylor has had a request from Simon Gregson. Simon's daughter is taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh awards and would like to do some volunteering work in the Church yard, cutting grass. He has requested that she volunteer her services at Carnaby Church and would like a letter to be written by the Chairman that she has volunteered her services with some basic details to show that she has complied with the Duke of Edinburgh awards. This was agreed by the committee.
