PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

Cllr Lissetter attended the meeting and informed us that the Ward Councillors are organising cluster meetings for Parish Councils to discuss topics of common interest which may be of benefit to them.

Woldgate 40 mile per hour signs have now been erected. The PC would like to know why only part of this area has been designated a 40 mile zone when other lanes adjoining Woldgate are still at national speed limits. Cllr Lissetter will make enquiries.

Cllr Jackson raised the issue about the soil which has been spread along the grass verge between Carnaby and Bridlington. The newly laid soil has been driven over and is now looking messy. It is unclear as to what purpose this was done. Cllr Lissetter will make enquiries.

Potholes- Carnaby and Haisthorpe have a number of potholes which have still to be mended. Clerk will inform ERYC again.

Utility companies, such as Yorkshire Water, are not repairing roads to a high standard after doing maintenance work. Most of the repairs are done at night when ERYC inspectors are off duty. Cllr Lissetter was informed about this and will speak to ERYC about this matter.

White lines in the village have still not been painted. Cllr Lissetter to chase this up.

12. Bikes to decorate village for Tour de Yorkshire. GW asked PC Milner if there were any bikes that we could have to decorate the village, unfortunately they do not have any.

Cllr Taylor, Cllr Kitching and Cllr Jackson stood down whilst planning of this application was discussed due to having a non-pecuniary interest in this matter.

5. Fraisthorpe Wind Farm Fund has now opened. (1st March). Applications will be opened twice a year. GW gave update about how funding would be dealt with and issues arising from the initial meeting. Cllr S Thomas was given a copy of the draft documents. GW will apply for litter picking equipment and more litter bins to help keep the Parish Tidy. It was discussed whether the PC should apply for cameras from the fund to help prevent crime and fly tipping in the village. This will be discussed in more detail next time.
