**PUBLIC QUESTION TIME**

GL attended the meeting to complain about the noise from the road surface and the noise of the manhole covers. There are 3 x manhole covers on Main Street that rattle when lorries, especially empty bulkies, drive over them. Yorkshire Water replaced one manhole at one o'clock in the morning. They replaced the only manhole cover that did not rattle. Request for the covers to be fixed properly. The road noise is also causing vibrations to the two buildings on the Main Street as they do not have any foundations. GW to pursue this with ERYC for a solution. Will request site visit or meeting to discuss further with Highways.

b) Email from Cllr Evison re requests for traffic survey. Clarity needed over figures supplied (ie 12,5000 vehicles over last 3 years, 14,5000 vehicles). Email also refers to “collision history” in Carnaby and that there has been no recorded casualties- this is taken into account when traffic calming measures/pedestrian crossings etc. Email also refers to low numbers of people crossing the road but no survey has been mentioned that would back this data up. Other measures, such as islands in the middle of the roads would involve widening the road and would constrict the road. ERYC sympathise but are going to take no action. GW to ask for clarification of numbers quoted and ask for proof of surveys. Traffic flow survey is requested by PC. GW to liaise with ERYC.

**7: CLERKS REPORT**

- Applications are now being accepted to support WW1 Centenary Commemorations. Parish Councils are requested to apply for up to £500 per project.
- We have received a request from a member of the public, Rob Fryer, (not of this Parish) to look at the cycle and footpaths to and from Bridlington. They are in poor repair and need looking at. Cllr Evison has responded and informs PC that there are some plans in place for cycle paths and the footpath to Bridlington will be looked and cleaned. Main issue of adding more footpaths is due to budget constraints.
- Cllr Daniels has looked into surveillance cameras. GW to contact company for more details.
- Road surface on Turkey Lane creating a problem – dip in road, dangerous when pulling up to Avondale. GW to contact ERYC
- Footpaths in the village and railway snicket are in need of trimming. GW to contact ERYC.
- Wheelie bins needed at Crossroads on Woldgate and end of carriage drive. GW to contact ERYC.
- Fire hydrant on Church Lane Carnaby is in a precarious position – bank has eroded exposing hydrant – danger of being broken by passing vehicles. GW to contact Fire brigade.
- Pole on the Pound has now been repaired after it was knocked down.
- Speed gun – GW to contact Debbie Fagan to request a speedgun for Parish Councillors to use.
