**8: CLERKS**

- Complaint from Bridlington Birds of Prey and Animal Park was received from the Director Paul Woodward. He is complaining about Park Rose Village converting land at the rear of the Park Rose Village and is apply for planning permission for 10 tent pitches outside the front of his centre. The PC has not yet received any notifications of any further planning but the complaint has been noted.
- Proposed Removal of Public Payphone – BT is planning on removing the payphone in the village of Carnaby. The Parish Councillors voted to remove the payphone but to adopt the phone box so that it can be retained as a local feature. It can be adopted for one pound. The vote was 5 for retaining the box and 1 vote against. As the majority voted for keeping the box the box will now remain.
- Update from Paula Parker re fly tipping. ERYC and Community Payback team apparently monitor Woldgate regularly for fly tipping and clean the area. However, Church Lane in particular is now being littered with alcohol cans, which have now been shredded when the verges were cut. Clerk to contact ERYC about the state of the lane and ask that a litter pick is done prior to any further verge cutting.
- Email from Cllr Evison regarding the state of the roads. ERYC are only refreshing anti skid surfaces on the roads approaching roundabouts or pedestrian crossing due to budget cuts, therefore there are no plans to resurface anti-skid surfaces in Carnaby at present. Cllr Evison has also made enquiries with the Community Payback Team to see if they can assist with cleaning the area. We have received no update as yet on this.
- Noticeboard for Haisthorpe . Clerk to source a new noticeboard for Haisthorpe for approximately £200-300 – donation received from North Wolds Lions to commemorate Her Majesty's 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday. Cllr Thomas will enquire about plagues for noticeboards.
- ERYC Rough Sleeper Estimate 2016 will take on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> November.
- NHS Formal public consultation is due to take place. ERYC is urging people to take part. Clerk will update web page asking for people to take part.
- AECOM questionnaire regarding changes to Landscape Character Assessment has been received. PC will comment about wind turbines in the area.
- Neighbourhood Watch Association – clerk will request signs to be erected on lampposts in the village to show that we are a member of this.
- Welfare Unit – it was suggested that in order to get the Community Payback team to litter pick in our area that we look at getting a mobile Welfare Unit so that they have toilet facilities and somewhere to eat when they visit the parish. It was also

suggested that other Parishes may wish to share this facility. Clerk will contact other Parishes to see if they are interested.

- Email from Rob Brown re bollards. The email states that the Pound is public highway which the PC dispute as it was formally adopted in the 1980's, approx. 1987. Clerk to respond to email disputing that this is public highway.
- Christmas – Clerk to order 3 dozen party sausage rolls and 2 dozen mince pies for Christmas, Cllr Daniels will buy presents for the children, mulled wine will also be available.
- Waste recycling – there has not been a meeting as yet. Clerk to chase this up
- GW gave an update about CAM. Cllr Kitching asked the PC if they would agree to put in planning permission on behalf of CAM. All councillors who are not involved with CAM agreed with the proposal (JL, JD, ST, DB)
- Wilsthorpe – Cllr Jackson raised the question about which are adopted roads in Wilsthorpe and drivers are receiving parking tickets for parking on some roads. Clerk will ask Highways for clarification.
