**PUBLIC QUESTION TIME:**

A local resident attended the meeting to raise further concerns at the continued cars racing and speeding on Sticks Lane, then travelling onto the Industrial Estate to meet and race on a weekly basis. The continued disruption is impacting on residents mental and physical health and the local residents would welcome a meeting with the council and police asap to sort the issue.

The points raised are detailed as follows;

Sticks Lane

- Nearly every weekend (& other evenings)
- Sticks Lane is a daily rat run
- Motorist exceeding the speed limit/racing side by side
- No regard for the safety of pedestrians/cyclists/riders
- Sticks Lane has a lot of extra residents and visitors using the lane now.
- Noise dreadful from Industrial Estate, sounds like a war zone, lots of revving and backfiring.
- Police called multiple times by residents, but no action seems to be taken (see Log Numbers collated)
- The Council needs to protect with people with road safety measures, and be proactive not reactive.

Carnaby Industrial Estate

- Complaints from businesses and workers being prevented from getting to & from work
- Racers claim that it's an Industrial estate and no one can stop them – is this true? If so; who owns the industrial estate? If the council own it, why can't the put in place conditions to prevent it?
