- Flytipping Cameras Cllr Daniels has been in contact with ERYC regarding providing CCTV to an area on Woldgate, ERYC have verbally quoted £2000 for supply & installation, however it was decided that further information is required before a decision could be made – Cllr Daniels is going to contact the relevant department at ERYC
- 2. Cllr Kitching raised concerns about the Woldgate road surface in icy/winter conditions, recently the road was closed due to this a resident of Woldgate has requested that grit bins be added, or piles of grit be left at side of road (like done in previous years) Cllr Dewhirst agreed to look into this
- 3. Cllr Langham advised there is a streetlight (no. 5) out on Moor Lane Clerk to report to ERYC
- 4. Unmetered Supplies it was agreed the Parish Council accepts the increase for the festive lighting Clerk to advise Northern Powergrid.
- 5. Proposed Three Oaks Renewable Energy Park community fund, the revised community funding proposal/S106 Agreement was discussed, it was agreed we would contact Liz Sellar's after the Burton Agnes PC February meeting, and we will reply jointly to Ridge Clean Energy (Developers).
